Reports:

- Secretary's Report: Don Kimminau presented the General Membership Meeting minutes for July which were approved as written.
- Treasurer's Report: Rick West presented the July Treasurer's Report which was approved as written.

- July's major income sources were Sentinel advertising, Fund Raisers, and Dues. Major Expenses were Admin (ALCOC Dues, NAVFOC Annual Dues), Communications (newsletter) and the Summer Social.
- Membership Vacant: President Robinson provided a membership status update.
 - o HCMOAA currently has 480 members, with 4 new members since our last meeting.
- Branch Concerns: none presented by membership-at-large
 - o Army: Arno Hoerle, not present
 - o USAF: Ed Uher, not present
 - o USN/USMC: not present
- Legislative: Jerry Haynes provided the following notification (from Fleet Reserve Assn):
 - o Effective October 1, 2013 Tricare will only reimburse VA 20% of allowable charge, vice the past practice of paying 80% for non-service connected care received in the VA, for Tricare for Life (TFL) beneficiaries rated at less than 50% disabled. While this is not a new law, it has not been enforced. The rationale that supports this change follows:
 - Although VA Facilities are Tricare-authorized, they are not Medicare-certified.
 - Medicare, by statute, cannot reimburse for care provided by a Government facility.
 - o Simply put, VA can't bill Medicare and Medicare can't reimburse VA for care.
 - o Since VA can't be Medicare-certified, it presents as an opt-out Medicare provider.
 - Therefore, Tricare reimburses VA what it would have paid if Medicare had been primary, which is 20% leaving you with a bill for the remaining 80%.
 - The solution: For less than 50% VA rated, use your TFL benefit in the community for nonservice connected TFL care to prevent being billed for 80% of the allowable charge.
- Hospitality: Carrie Hightower gave a special invite to our new members for the June and December Member Socials.

President's Comments:

- HCMOAA received the 5-Star Level of Excellence Award for the second year in a row. President Robinson will be attending the MOAA Annual meeting to accept.
