I am the President of the Huntsville Chapter, Military Officers Association of America (MOAA), which is comprised of active duty, reserve and National Guard, former and retired military officers from all services. Our Chapter goals include recognizing the top ROTC / JROTC cadets at area high schools and colleges, providing scholarship funds to area college / college-bound students, and participating in events such as a Memorial Day wreath-laying ceremony, a summer BBQ at the Tut Fann Veterans Home, and Veterans Day activities.

Our Chapter conducts a golf tournament each Fall to raise funds for our scholarship program. This year, the tournament will be held September 20, 2018 at The Links at Redstone - along with the Redstone Arsenal Retirees Appreciation Day.
