I am the President of the Huntsville Chapter, Military Officers Association of America (HCMOAA), which is comprised of active duty, reserve and National Guard, former and retired military officers from all services. Our Chapter goals include recognizing the top ROTC / JROTC cadets at area high schools and colleges, providing scholarship funds to area college / college-bound students, and participating in community events such as a Memorial Day wreath ceremony, a summer BBQ at the Tut Fann Veterans Home, and Veterans Day / Heroes' Week activities.
